Design aesthetic

Think about:

- → Color palette
- → Mood
- → Style
- → Lighting

Consistency

- → Identify your aesthetic and stick with it!
- Use the pre-download complimentary versions of images to make a moodboard.
- Use your moodboard to make sure your images are cohesive; then purchase the files.

Search criteria

Try several different search terms and think about:

- > Dimensions and cropping
- > Point of view
- Depth of field
- Demographics

Editing

Make small tweaks to enhance the image, such as:

- Cropping
- Applying a blur filter
- Adjusting the colors
- Reducing contrast and layering with text
